School-Held Funds \$16,640.) Note: account balances do not include fun lunch liabilities (vendors to be paid), but does include fun lunch pre-payments, of which the balance is estimated to be \$10,000 owing. Based on the PAC spending survey results, Megan presented word clouds representing how Torquay parents want money spent - emphasis on outdoor time, nature studies, and accessibility. PAC and school administration have identified several big-ticket items (below) that will require funding from PAC for their success.
